Vaccinations should only be undertaken following a full consultation with the Practice Nurse, including details of your medical history and planned activities. Before departure, all travellers should ensure that they are up to date with the routine NHS childhood vaccinations, e.g. diphtheria, tetanus and polio (DTP) and measles, mumps and rubella (MMR).

It is important to make an initial appointment as early as possible - **at least 8 weeks** before you travel - as a second appointment will be required with the practice nurse to actually receive the vaccinations. These vaccines have to be ordered as they are not a stock vaccine. Your second appointment needs to be at least 2 weeks before you travel to allow the vaccines to work.

* The Practice Nurse will advise whether 3 or 4 doses are required following your initial consultation
